Eisenhower Memorial Finalists Announced

The Dwight D. Eisenhower Memorial Commission has announced its short list of seven prospective designers, one of whom will be chosen to design the memorial in Washington for Eisenhower, the 34th president. The seven are Frank Gehry of Gehry Partners, Ralph Johnson of Perkins & Will, Ron Krueck of Krueck & Sexton, Rob Rogers and Jonathan Marvel of Rogers Marvel Architects, Moshe Safdie of Moshe Safdie & Associates, Stanley Saitowitz of Natoma Architects and Peter Walker of PWP Landscape Architecture. The final selection is scheduled for late March; the memorial will be built on a four-acre site between Fourth and Sixth Streets SW, south of Independence Avenue and near the Department of Education and the National Air and Space Museum.
